

Pakistan's Cataract Surgical Rate (CSR) was 2,819 surgeries per million in 2014, as compared to the US CSR of 11,000.

Seva's Approach in Pakistan

Approximately 4% of the world's blind live in Pakistan. With 1.7 million people blind, many have limited access to eye care. Most of Pakistan's trained ophthalmologists work in urban areas at government or private clinics, making accessible and affordable eye care a concern in rural communities. Women living in rural areas are especially vulnerable, as social constraints inhibit their ability to travel to receive necessary services.

Seva strengthens eye care programs in rural Pakistan with our partner, Comprehensive Health & Education Forum (CHEF) International. Seva's work with CHEF International is focused on providing quality and affordable eye care to the farming community of Buner. Together, Seva and CHEF established an eye care center in Buner in 2017 providing accessible, affordable and sustainable eye care services to the community.

Seva supports CHEF International with local staff development, operational improvements, and funding for direct services. With this support, Seva has helped CHEF become a resource to other Pakistani eye hospitals.



SPOTLIGHT ON INCREASING ACCESS

58-year-old Munir was identified with cataracts in both eyes during a free eye camp in his village. Munir is a watchman by profession and his cataracts affected his job. He was unable to carry out his duties accurately. Munir always asked for help from his colleagues. He often complained of headache. He could not explain his issues due to the stigma surrounding disabilities in his line of work. After beining screened, he was referred to Takhtbhai Eye Hospital of CHEF International, where they operated on him free of cost. Now, he gains confidence with every passing day because his eyesight issues were resolved.
